

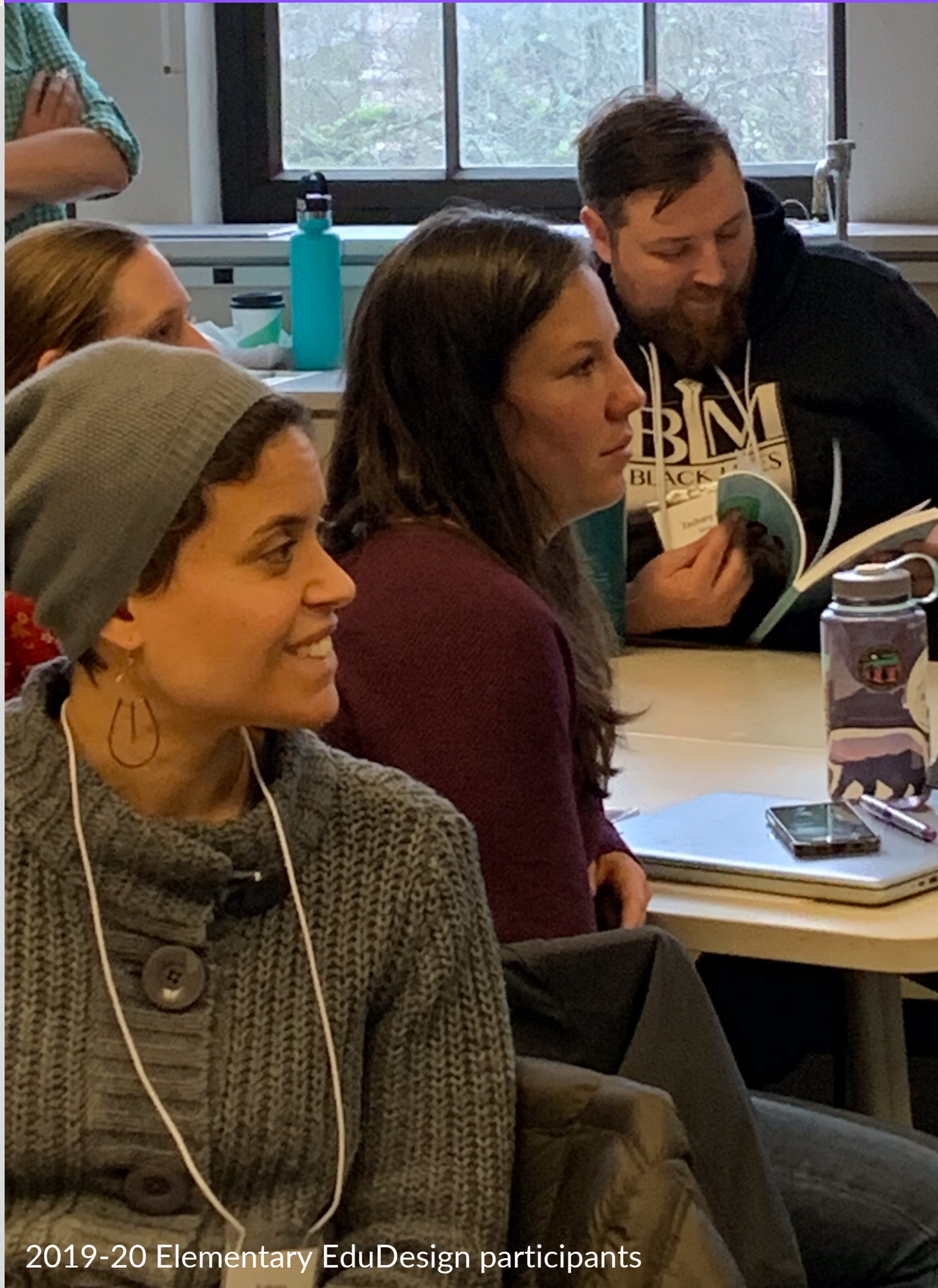
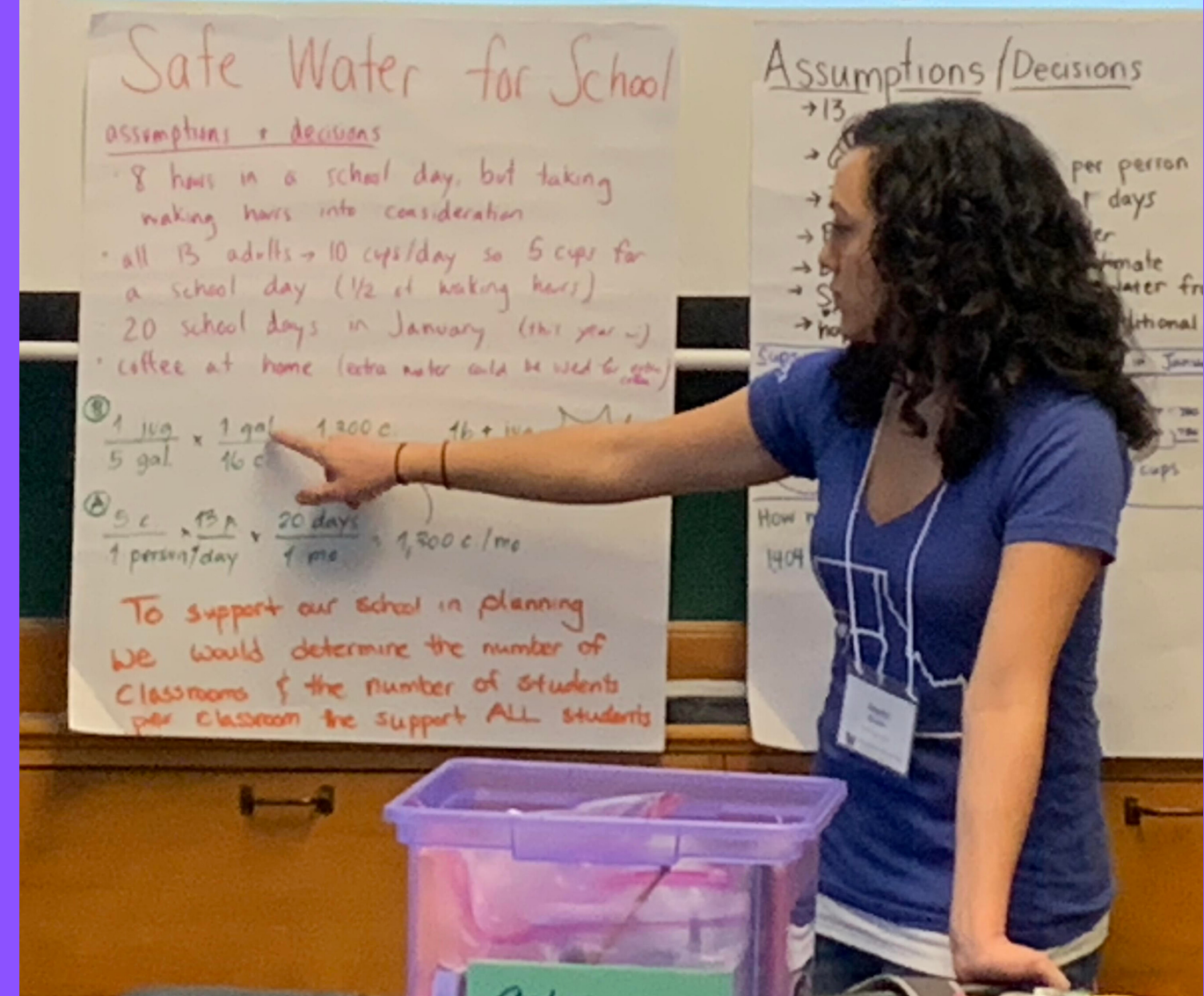


K-8 DUAL LANGUAGE EDUDESIGN FELLOWSHIP: 2020-21
